### Footnotes

ANNIE'S AWARD saved ground tracking the pacesetters to the stretch, angled out entering the lane, rallied to challenge in midstretch and drew off under urging. DEVILISH CANDY dueled outside a rival on the backstretch, went clear midway on the turn, was overtaken by the winner leaving the furlong marker, just saved second. M. J. EXPRESS moved closer while racing three wide on the turn, finished evenly and just missed second. NOBLE KITTY saved ground while trailing the field to the stretch, moved closer entering the lane but failed to produce a late bid. OHIO SOCIETY dueled along the rail to midway on the turn before tiring. TIFFANY'S AWARD chased from the two path to the stretch before tiring.
