MR PERFECT was outpaced along the inside, angled out eight wide into the stretch, rallied strongly and was going away at the finish. JOHNIES STORM chased the pace, gained the lead at the furlong marker, stayed on but was no match for the top one. CAPTAIN CORELLI set a demanding pace and yielded in the final furlong. ZANY NORTHWESTERN raced in the first flight while six wide, made a bid on the turn, entered the stretch six wide and tired. PERFECTO WESTO settled wee, moved seven wide into the stretch and lodged a mild bid. NAPOLEON J raced forwardly but dropped back on the turn. AIR BORNE ETBAUER stalked the pace and faltered. WANNA MAKE IT never menaced. WOODHUGH was off slowly and outrun.
