FINAL ANSWER was away quickly and sent to the lead while saving ground, drew off on the far turn and was under heavy handling to add to the margin late. ACHIEVABLE was unhurried early while saving ground, rallied on the far turn and into the stretch, could not get to and was no match for the winner, gamely held the place. HIMLER was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too late. INSPECTOR MORSE stalked the pace while never far back, ran evenly with no rally. CANFIELD was well placed while five wide, had no rally. SHOW ME THE CASH prompted the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. RAPID SURVIVOR failed to menace. AXEL SWAGGER was no threat. PRECIPICE TRAIL showed good early speed chasing the pace, stopped and dropped back.
