Footnotes

CAMERO rushed to contention approaching the turn, moved up to press the pace outside of ENGEN midway on the turn, dueled to midstretch before drawing off late under urging despite failing to switch leads through the drive. DOC DOT COM broke a step slow, rushed up along the rail to reach contention approaching the turn, steadied off heels and was shuffled back, came off the rail approaching the stretch and finished strongly to gain the place in the final stride. BEAUTIMUS raced close up while three wide to the stretch, finished evenly and gained third at the wire. ENGEN set the pace until headed by the winner midway on the turn, dueled inside that rival to the final furlong, proved no match, tired late and lost the minor awards in the final strides. CRAZY ALICE raced close up while three wide to the stretch before weakening. SEEYAKA angled four wide approaching the stretch but was never a factor. RED QUILLA COUNTRY was outrun. WENDY SALLY raced close up early before breaking down and falling at the seven sixteenths marker.
