Footnotes

LONGEST SHOT unhurried early to the turn, rallied through the drive to be along in time. HOUSEBUILDER dueled early from inside, chased into the stretch and missed at the wire. SHINE FOR STEVE unhurried early, raced outside past the quarter pole, switched to the inside through the stretch and rallied late. SIXANDTHREE had good speed to duel early, drew clear into the turn but weakened grudgingly late. FRENCHMAN'S COVE raced evenly and lacked a late response when needed. ZEBULON ROAD improved position only. DIAMOND ROLL raced close up to the turn but faded thereafter. TALK TO DA MANAGER faded into the stretch. MCFRENCH tracked to the turn but stopped readily.
