GOLD TERRITORY stalked the pace while never far back and off the rail, responded when asked in the stretch, was all out to hold sway late. AREQUIPA was in a good stalking position and showed good early speed, rallied into the stretch but found her best stride late and was gaining. SCRAPER was well placed in mid pack, rallied four wide on the turn and loomed a threat in upper stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. EDDIE'S LADY was unhurried early on the inside, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. BRENDA'S WAMPUM was unhurried early while five wide, ran evenly with no rally. RABIOSA bore out at the start, flashed brief speed chasing the pace, stopped and dropped back. HEART TO ME flashed brief speed before stopping. HERE'S KIKI was off slowly, was no factor.
