Footnotes

SUPER CHILD chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch and drove past the leader while clearing the field late. UP AND AWAY pressed the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. KEY TO LUCK tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then angled into the inside in the stretch and flattened out late in the drive. HOW'S BAYOU angled off the rail into the turn and was empty late in the stretch run. A LITTLE GRAND set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and gave way late in the stretch. WEB WE WEAWE trailed the field throughout.
