ATS GOOD pressed the pace early then took over command, angled into the three path in the turn then drew clear in the stretch and held sway in the late stages. THE BUCKEYE HERO tracked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch and held place late. WILL E SCAT was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the turn then was gaining late in the stretch and just missed place. NORTH OF ALASKA stalked the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch drive. MY BEST CHANCE was never a threat. DOOMER was done early. FEASTORFAMINE had brief speed then stopped.
