CLASSIC MAURA was unhurried early on the outside, rallied on the turn and drew off in the stretch, was under heavy pressure to increase the margin while on the outside. CHRISTMAS EVE was in a good stalking position in mid pack, rallied into the stretch, could not get to and was no match for the winner, was second best. ZULEMA N stalked and pressed the pace from the outside, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. NELL'S HONEY was void of early speed, improved position but was no threat. STAR CRAZY set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. FANCY TIFF was no factor. ARCEUS flashed brief speed before fading. LUCKY LOVER showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back. VALLEY BOOMER showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back.
