DOUBLED VISION was well placed while four wide, rallied on the turn and loomed a threat, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. JUJU BLING was unhurried early while four wide, ran evenly with no rally. DIXIE PIXIE set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. MARKET GENIUS failed to menace.
