CHASE THE BLAZE dueled for the lead and set the pace while saving ground, was headed in upper stretch, was all out to hold sway late. MY BEST CHANCE was well placed and saved ground, was angled out and rallied into the stretch, could not get past the winner late and just missed. HEISMAN STAR dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, took the lead in upper stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. POWERBALL TOO was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too late. JOHN THE BANKER showed good early speed while four wide, gave way and dropped back. KINKCACHU lunged at the start and failed to menace.
