### Footnotes

DOOMER dueled for the lead and pressed the pace while six wide, drew clear late stretch and drew clear under heavy pressure. KESAGAMI stalked the pace while four wide, rallied into the stretch and drew clear, weakened and ran evenly late. LUCCIROCKINBUCCI was unhurried early while four wide, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. TRACK RECORD was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. LIFEINTHETROPICS was well placed while five wide, ran evenly with no rally. RETRIEVER dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered and faded. STORM LEADER failed to menace. SPRING BLUES flashed brief speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back. IQUITAROD was no factor. TEEBERRY showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back.
