CASINO ROYAL never far back, went after winner into the stretch but was no match while clearly second best. INDIAN COURAGE well placed while never far back but failed to gain in the stretch. KING MACHO up close from between horses to turn but faded in the drive. RAMBLIN MIKE failed to reach contention and floated very wide into the stretch run. POWERBALL TOO raced a wide trip. HEPHAESTUS saved ground to no avail.
