CHESAPEAKE BAY no speed from the outset, rallied six or seven wide into the stretch finished well and drove past the leaders in the final furlong to win going away. LITTLE STOGIE close up, gained a short lead turning for home, led into the final furlong but was outfinished late. AURORA'S SECRET never far back, came with a four wide run into the stretch but flattened out in the drive. Q BIG TOP had no speed from from far outside at the quarter pole, began lugging in badly through the stretch run with a mild gain inside. CLASSY WONDER dueled between horses early, stayed well to deep stretch but faltered late. FIRE UNDER CONTROL showed good speed to vie for the lead inside early but gave way readily. HURRICANE RIB lunged at the start and was never a menace. EAST ON STROOP was never a factor. GREG dropped far back.
