CALL ME NOW pressed the pace while four wide, drifted in mid stretch, rallied and drew clear late under constant handling. UNBRIDLED DAVID dueled for the lead and set the pace, drew off in upper stretch while saving ground, gave way and had no late closing kick. PHILLY FRENZY was in a good stalking position in mid pack while four wide, had a mild late rally. MOROX was void of early speed, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. PLURIES flashed brief speed before stopping. BOOGIEMANBALL was void of early speed while six and seven wide, had mild late rally. ST JOSEPHINES flashed brief speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back. STORM THIS showed good early speed chasing the pace, faltered and faded. SNOWBOARD RIDGE failed to menace. NEW YORK BOBBY failed to menace. LEGIONARY was no factor.
