TIGHT MONEY was void of early speed, rallied into the stretch and being fanned seven wide in the stretch, close with a rush and was fully extended to draw clear late. TUT'S SHADOW stalked the pace with good early speed, rallied on the turn and dueled, drew clear in the stretch, faltered late and was outfinished to the wire. POLLY PEPPERSTONE was well placed on the outside, rallied on the turn and dueled into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and began to fade. RESULTA was in a good stalking position, ran evenly with no rally. SECRET SONADOR was no factor but did improve position. HOSPITALITYFLIGHT stalked the pace mid pack, had no rally. GALLOWAY set the pace with good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back. SUN SPIRIT bobbled at the start and was no factor.
