JO DANCER lunged at the start and spotted the field several lengths, was unhurried while saving ground, was angled out and split horses mid stretch, drew off while fully extended. SAVE N TIME was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch and loomed a threat, could not go with the winner but gamely held the place. SAILFIN stalked the pace while four wide, rallied into the stretch and led briefly, weakened and began to fade late. BEA'S TREASURE was well placed in mid pack, rallied into the stretch, hung and ran evenly late. MY FRIEND BERNIE showed good early speed while five wide, gave way and dropped back. ROMAN HALL set the pace with good early speed, was used up and dropped back.
