PRINCESS DE ORO stalked the pace while never far back on the outside, rallied on the far turn and into the stretch, was all out to prevail in a long drive. ROCKIN INTHE RAIN dueled for the lead and set the pace, dueled and drew clear on the far turn, led in late stretch, the rider lost the whip and was outfinished to the wire. SUPER CHILD was well placed early and showed good early speed, gave way in the stretch and dropped back. EDDIKINS was no factor, improved position. UPUPANDGO failed to menace. SARAH DOUGLAS showed good early speed chasing the pace, was through after a half mile and dropped back. N J ESQ was no factor. EMILY SUN SHINE set the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back.
