GABRIEL'S REVENGE was unhurried early while seven wide, rallied on the turn and drew off in upper stretch, was under firm handling to the wire. SKYLIGHT WARRIOR was in a good stalking position while four wide, rallied on the turn and loomed a threat, hung in the stretch and ran evenly late. PHEASANT LANE was void of early speed, improved position in the stretch but was no threat to the top two. DREADWOOD was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. PRIVATE AFFAIR set the pace with good early speed while saving ground, faltered and faded. HABASAC failed to menace. YOUTHFUL SPIRIT was no factor.
