FINAL ANSWER set the pace with good early speed while off the rail, drew off in upper stretch, was all out to hold sway late. BOBS TIEBREAKER stalked the pace with good early speed, rallied on the far turn, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. COMEBACK was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too late. STALWART TEE was no factor, improved position. VINTIEME was well placed and showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. KAUFMAN failed to menace. FINGER TAPPING flashed brief speed, stopped and dropped back.
