GIMMEAROCK was unhurried early while saving ground, rallied into the stretch and got through along the rail, drew off under constant pressure. PROSPECT WILD bore in at the start and bothered foes, set the pace while off the rail, gamely held the place. TRAFFIC LEADER was in a good stalking position while five wide, rallied on the turn and loomed a threat, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. FLAK JACKET was void of early speed, improved position but was no factor. BAU BAI GOLD failed to menace. STORMY STAR showed good early speed chasing the pace, was through after a half mile and dropped back. PEPPERMINT STRINGS stumbled at the start, was rushed to contention and used up, dropped back. METEORITE failed to menace.
