CHILLINESS was void of early speed, rallied on the far turn and into the stretch while seven wide, circled the field and drew off while fully extended. THREE TICKETS dueled for the lead and set the pace, weakened in the stretch but gamely held the place. SINGALONGWITH BERT was well placed while five wide, rallied on the backstretch and prompted the pace, failed to sustain the bid and dropped back. TREKKIE was void of early speed, rallied into the stretch and loomed a threat, hung and ran evenly late. UNTUTTTABLE MOMENT failed to menace. PANDA showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back. PRINCE DAVID flashed brief speed before stopping. Delayed the start due to a late jockey change. ALABAMA GOLD was no factor.
