HIGH INTELLECT was in a good stalking position in mid pack while five and six wide and rallied into the stretch, dueled in late stretch and was all out to hold sway late. KESAGAMI was void of early speed while seven wide and lost ground, rallied into the stretch, dueled late but was outfinished to the wire. RETRIEVER was well placed on the inside, was taken up entering the turn while in tight, flattened out and ran evenly late. MUSIC FAN was well placed while five wide, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. DETROIT'S DANCER pressed the pace early, gave way and dropped back. LUCCIROCKINBUCCI stalked the pace while saving ground, ran evenly with no rally. PEACE AND JOY showed good early speed chasing the pace, faltered and faded. INTENSLYCONFUZZLED set the pace with good early speed, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. CIANO NIGHTS failed to menace. BURNIN N TURNIN was no factor.
