Footnotes

COMEBACK pressed the leader to deep stretch, rallied through the final sixteenth to wear down the leader in a game effort. IQUITAROD had good speed to set pace to deep stretch but was run down in the shadow of the wire. MY FRIEND BERNIE never far back, was pushed inside MUDD TRACKER early, stayed close to the rail with a mild late gain. MUDD TRACKER was up close early on, came in on MY FRIEND BERNIE down the backstretch and raced evenly late from inside. SALT FLATS chased the leaders to the turn but faltered in the drive. MINE AT THE MOMENT was bounced around after the start and improved position while wide through the stretch. FOUR EYED FRED never far back, came four wide into the stretch with no bid. RUNNINGROOSTER raced a wide trip.
