ZIMMARON KID set the pace with good early speed while off the rail, was well handled and responded when asked in upper stretch and drew off, was under constant handling to the wire. SPANTASTIC was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. TRACK RECORD bobbled at the start and then stalked the pace while five wide and lost ground, rallied on the second turn, hung and dropped back. POINTING HOME was well placed with good early speed, rallied on the far turn, faltered and faded. HELLO FROM HEAVEN failed to menace. QUE RICO flashed brief speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back.
