THUNDER OF HOPE stalked the pace while four wide, rallied into the stretch and dueled, drew clear under firm handling. CHROME CRUISER dueled for the lead and pressed the pace from the inside, weakened in the stretch but was second best. GOOD AND EVIL set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. VIVENDI'S VERDICT stumbled at the start, was never a factor. CHROMATIC flashed brief speed before stopping. MARKET GENIUS failed to menace. PRINCESS JUANITA was no factor.
