QUICK CARNAGE speed to battle on the front end, dug in gamely through the stretch and prevailed in a long drive. MOON IS A STAR vied from three wide into the stretch, dueled winner through the final furlong but just missed at the wire. THE RIGHT FACE well placed while never far back, came with a four wide run into the stretch with a mild gain. RAT LIKE CUNNING close up to the turn, floated wide into the stretch with no late bid. MY MONEY failed to menace. HOLY ROMAN EMPIRE raced evenly from close to the rail throughout. IRON BISON vied from inside to the stretch but faded in the stretch. PRIZE MONEY failed to menace. QUICK AMERICAN was no threat. HALLELUJAH SQUARE was always outrun.
