Footnotes

DOOMER duled for the lead and set the pace from the inside, was headed in the stretch, came again late and drew off under constant handling. FRANTIC DOMER was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch on the outside and loomed a threat, flattened out and ran evenly late. ARRESTEDBYMISTAKE was void of early speed, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. PHIL THE THRILL duled for the lead and set the pace from the outside, faltered and faded. CUCINA NICK was void of early speed, had a mild late rally. GREEN N GOLDIE was six wide and failed to menace. HEPHAESTUS showed good early speed while four wide, was through after a half mile and dropped back. CAT AND CUSTARD flashed brief speed before stopping.
