WILD ROVER stalked the pace while saving ground, was angled out into the stretch and rallied, dueled but was outfinished to the wire. REWARDING CALMA dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered and faded. HOMESTEAD STRIKE showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back. HABASAC was unhurried early while six wide and lost ground, had no rally. MONKEY MAN failed to menace. JACOBS SHADOW flashed brief speed, stopped and faded. RUNNINGONLOVE was no factor. FIVE STAR SUCCESS was no threat.
