RAISE THE REWARD was void of early speed while six wide and lost ground, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but waited too late. DANCE FLOOR MANIAC set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. DANCING DON was unhurried early, was checked repeatedly on the turn while saving ground, had no rally. WHERESTHELIMIT stalked the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. BIG PHONE BILL failed to menace.
