BROTHER THOMAS stalked the loose leader to the stretch, rallied to take the lead a sixteenth out and drew clear under urging. RAMBLIN MIKE raced four wide while advancing on the turn, finished willingly to gain the place late. RAISING COMOTION sprinted clear early, maintained his advantage to the stretch, weakened through the final furlong. SPIRIT OF GLORY raced well off the pace to the stretch, split rivals in the final sixteenth, had a mild rally and just missed the show spot. NAVIRE DE GUERRE raced within striking range in midpack to the stretch, did not rally. PRINCETON BLUE saved ground chasing the pacesetters to the stretch, also failed to rally. MORE GOLD raced four wide on the turn and never threatened. KINETIC ENERGY broke a step slow, was hard sent to move into midpack early, was never a factor. JAZZCEE J was outrun.
