### Footnotes

SUPRISE SWITCH had good position from inside, angled out for the drive and drew off in the stretch. PRIZE FEVER hard used to duel for the lead, held well to deep stretch and gamely stayed for place. IRISH TUNE dueled from inside to deep stretch but weakened in the drive. TH HILLS ARE ALIVE steadied into the first turn, raced evenly and lacked a late response. PINNACLE LADY raced close up to deep stretch while off rail but lacked a late bid. CACTUS PARK was never a factor. CHAMPANNIE was through early. TATIBITATI checked hard into the first turn and never menaced. SILENT JET had no speed, made a run outside into the final turn but went bad and was pulled up in late stretch but walked off.
