### Footnotes

FLIGHT ELEVEN saved ground while never far back, rallied around the turn and the up rail to be along in time. PRINCESS CHERYL good speed from outside, angled over to a clear lead in deep stretch but was run down in the final strides. THIS IS MY CASE was off slow, raced back from inside to the stretch, angled out for the drive and was gaining late for show. CATABLUE dueled early, stayed with pace to the stretch, drifted out into the lane and weakened late. GORGEOUS PROSPECT had good position to the stretch and gave way readily. HEAVENLY SUNLIGHT was never a threat. SMART REASON and STRIKE YOUR FANCY were both through early. PAULA'S PLANET failed to menace with a wide trip. FLIGHT ATTENDANT was always outrun.
