CALIFORNIA LION was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch and was just up at the wire. TREKKIE pressed the pace early while three wide, angled off the rail into the far turn then led in the stretch while clear but was caught at the wire. STRAIT OF MEWSINA (IRE) tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but hung in the final stages. SINGALONGWITH BERT was well placed early, angled into the three path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late. LIFEINTHETROPICS dueled early from between horses, angled into the three path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch run. THREE TICKETS dueled early from the inside, angled off the rail into the far turn and faded late. PRIME DIAMOND was never involved. JOHN THE BANKER was pulled up and vanned off.
