### Footnotes

POTENTIAL ARGUMENT set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then drew away late in the stretch under a steady drive. CHARLES ANTHONY chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn and was up for place late. FRANCIS MICHAEL pressed the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late. MIDNIGHT VADER stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and lacked a late gain in the stretch run. HARRY CANARY tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but faded late. CLASSIC RIDGE was never a threat. SAVOR THE FLAVOR was done early. LAST EFFORT had brief speed then folded up. POTENTIAL ARGUMENT WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST TO UNPLACED FOR A MEDICATION VIOLATION.
