IMMORTAL WINK was back early, angled into the four path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch and drifted in a bit while up at the wire. MOUNTAIN THUNDER tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then drifted out late in the stretch and was caught at the wire. TONE IT DOWN was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but lost the path and had to steady in the final stages. SKY TAPS angled into the three path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. PRECIPICE TRAIL pressed the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the far turn and faded late. TAX MAN SAM set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faltered late. WEEKEND WONDER had early speed then folded up. MAGICAL PARK bobbled at the start then was rushed up and eventually spent. INSPECTOR MORSE was never involved. EL POLLO VOLANDO was done early. THE RIDER OF TONE IT DOWN CLAIMED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF MOUNTAIN THUNDER AND THE RIDER OF IMMORTAL WINK FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE LATE STRETCH BUT IT WAS DISALLOWED.
