UP FOR ADOPTION was void of early speed, had a steady advance towards the front, was all out to get up in the final strides. THUNDER STORM was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch and led, was outfinished to the wire. KENDALLS WISH was in a good stalking position in mid pack, rallied into the stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. R GOLDEN MOMENT stalked the pace while never far back, ran evenly with no rally. KIAN HEAT was well placed in mid pack, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. LUCKY CHALLENGE set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. LUCKY OKIE showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. TETON'S TOT flashed brief speed chasing the pace, stopped and dropped back. LORD BULL was no factor and was eased.
