### Footnotes

RAMBLIN SALLY dueled for the lead and set the pace while off the rail drew clear on the far turn, was all out to hold sway late. MY THREE EX WIVES was unhurried early, rallied on the far turn and into the stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. IDAPRESS stalked the pace on the outside, rallied on the second turn, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. PROUD 'N GOLD bobbled and was off slowly, improved position but was no factor. ROYAL RHAPSODY was void of early speed, improved position but was no threat. CRAFTY GIGI was well placed in mid pack, had no rally. SO EASY stalked the pace with good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back. GOLD IN THE SAND failed to menace. UNSTOPPABLE ME dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered and faded. FAIREST CONTENDER showed good early speed chasing the pace, stopped on the far turn and faded readily.
