WAR SPECIAL dueled from between rivals to midway on the turn, kicked well clear in upper stretch and held sway late under urging. PATTI'S CLOWN bobbled leaving the gate, made a four wide bid outside of the winner on the turn, couldn't keep pace in upper stretch, continued willingly and was gaining again late to narrowly miss. RED HOT HELEN raced close up in midpack early, dropped back from the rail on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and had a mild rally. SWEET CHERE was never a factor. BRENDA FROM DIXIE dueled outside rivals on the backstretch, slipped back a bit entering the turn and weakened. SHE'LL SHO GO broke very slowly and showed little thereafter. ESSEX GIRL pressed the pace racing along the rail to midway on the turn before tiring.
