FAIR ELIZA reluctant to load into the starting gate, won a battle for the early lead, responded to right-handed pressure through the stretch and held sway. MOON SHINE TIME vied for the lead between rivals, was urged around the turn, stayed on but could not get on terms with the victor. AWARD YU void of early speed, entered the stretch four wide and exhibited late interest. STAGE DOOR PENNY outpaced early, swung ten wide into the stretch and produced a mild bid. M. J. EXPRESS passed tired ones. OHIO VOLUNTEER never menaced. VANNING WEST was no factor. SPICY COLONY chased the early pace while five wide and retreated. PRECISE NIGHT broke well, duelled for the early lead and faltered.
