**Footnotes**

PROMISE HER DAMOON was in a good stalking position in mid pack, rallied into the stretch and wore down the rivals, was under heavy pressure to the wire. PHIL THE THRILL set the pace with good early speed, ducked in and was steadied mid stretch, gamely held the place. PETRUCHIO lunged at the start, stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the stretch, lacked the needed late response. TRAIL BOSS was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain. QUICK CARNAGE was no threat. CAMP CHINA failed to menace.
