BLIND AS A BAT was unhurried early, had a steady advance towards the front, drew clear late under heavy pressure. MARY LYNNE AND EYE was in a good stalking position, rallied into the stretch and drew clear, could not go with the winner but gamely held the place. MELE was void of early speed, rallied into the stretch and loomed a threat, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. DEPUTY'S LIL GIRL was well placed on the outside, rallied on the far turn, hung in the stretch and began to fade. LOOT D'LOO pressed the pace and dueled for the lead, faltered and faded. DOUBLEDIAMONDBABY was void of early speed, improved position but was no factor. STORM AND BEERS failed to menace. INDYS SIERRA set the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. CRESCENT MOON LADY showed good early speed chasing the pace, was through after a half mile and weakened. LIVE TODAY dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered and faded.
