### Footnotes

ALEXIS' STAR sprinted clear early, was headed approaching the final turn, dueled around the bend, kicked clear again entering the stretch and held sway late under urging. FUN AT HEART broke a step slow, chased the pacesetters from the two path to the stretch, finished willingly and was gaining outside of the winner late. VICTORIAN DAMASK raced close up early, made a bid outside of the winner leaving the half mile marker, dueled around the final turn, weakened slightly through the stretch. MACOCHEE GOLD saved ground tracking the pacesetters to the stretch, failed to produce the needed late bid. TIMLESS JEWELL raced just off the pace while three wide to the final turn before tiring. RASH DECISION broke slowly and showed little thereafter. SANDALIAS was outrun.
