COME ON GARCON was unhurried early in mid pack, rallied into the stretch and closed with a rush, drew clear late under firm handling. MONEYINTHECUVEE dueled for the lead and set the pace, led late but could not go with the winner, gamely held the place. MR. TURNABOUT dueled for the lead and pressed the pace from the inside, gave way grudgingly and ran evenly late. SAINT CHOCOLATE was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. GRIFFINSTOWN was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch but found his best stride late and was gaining. RAKEEN ORATORY dueled for the lead and set the pace from the inside, faltered and faded. MAGICAL PARK was in good stalking position in mid pack, had no rally. HALO'S WHO failed to menace.
