Footnotes

PERFECT TIME raced within striking range while four wide on the turn, rallied to take the lead leaving the furlong marker and drew clear under mild urging despite failing to switch leads. BALLROOM DANCER raced close up along the rail on the backstretch, bid for the lead inside of LAFAYETTE WILLA approaching the stretch, briefly inched clear in upper stretch but proved no match for the winner. LAFAYETTE WILLA set the pace while racing in the two path to the stretch, weakened through the drive. SWEET PICK flashed speed to vie for the lead from between horses early, slipped back into a stalking position approaching the turn, angled out in midstretch but failed to rally. GENSALE broke a bit slow, showed little thereafter while racing inside. LILLIE LEE wearing a nasal strip, vied for the lead on the backstretch before dropping back on the turn while racing three wide. MANDINGO was outrun.
