FINGER TAPPING set all of the pace with good early speed, rallied into the stretch, drew off under heavy pressure while well off the rail. HOT PROPOSITION was well placed and showed good early speed, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. WEEKEND WONDER was in a good stalking position in mid pack, rallied on the far turn, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. IMMORTAL WINK was unhurried early, improved position but was no factor. BRINKER showed good early speed, faltered and faded. GRAFTON failed to menace. PAYING THE BILL was no factor. WHERE THERE'S SMOKE showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back.
