**Footnotes**

RARE RUM raced along the rail in midpack to the stretch, rallied inside of SOLO BLITZ to take the lead a hundred yards out and drew clear under urging. PALM CANYON trailed to the stretch, swung wide entering the lane, finished fastest to gain second in the final jump. SOLO BLITZ set the pace under pressure to midway on the turn, inched clear approaching the stretch, maintained her advantage to the final sixteenth but weakened late while failing to switch leads through the lane. SO SOFT SUZY raced five wide on the turn and had a late rally to narrowly miss third. DECORATED AT DAWN raced just off the dueling leaders on the backstretch, made a three wide bid on the turn but failed to sustain her run and weakened through the drive. CURRENT HITTER vied for the lead along the rail on the backstretch, remained a forward factor to the stretch before tiring. LIZ'S SECRET was never a factor. BLUSHING CALLER raced within striking range from the two path to the stretch before weakening. SHADOW OF THE WIRE raced three wide in midpack to the stretch before giving way. KANRUN was outrun.
