GEAUX BAYOU lunged at the start, was unhurried early in mid pack, rallied on the far turn and drew clear, was under constant handling to hold the margin late. MY FRIEND KEN was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. POWER IN THE SKY was unhurried early, improved position but was no threat. TOTHELEFTTOTOHELEFT was taken back early and was unhurried, improved position but was no factor. FRANKIE'S FANTASY dueled for the lead and prompted the pace, gave way and dropped back. FIX IT BILL flashed brief speed before stopping. SKY DANCER pressed the pace and dueled for the lead, faltered and faded. NIGHTMARE ALLEY dueled for the lead and set the pace, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
