WANNABETHEBISCUIT pressed the pace with good early speed, rallied into the stretch and dueled, drew clear late under heavy pressure. DARE HE GOES was in a good stalking position in mid pack, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. PREMIER COURT dueled for the lead and prompted the pace from the outside, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. JOHN THE BANKER dueled for the lead set the pace, faltered in the stretch and began to fade. WININGS WIN WINNER showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. EAST ON STROOP bobbled at the start, failed to menace. CHASE THE BLAZE stalked the pace in mid pack, had no rally. ROCKETRY was no factor.
