O'RIAIN dueled for the lead and set all of the pace while saving ground, responded when asked in the stretch and drew off under constant urging. P. P'S TO FOLLOW stalked the pace while never far back on the outside, rallied on the far turn and loomed boldly, failed to sustain the bid but gamely held the place. PYRITE SPRINGS bobbled at the start and was then rushed up, gave way and ran evenly late. CONVEXITY was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with no rally. INITFORTHEMONEY failed to menace. STILL SMOLDERING was no factor. AURORA'S SECRET was no threat.
